## Cyclists raise money for sarcoma research

The Shriver family of Ossining, along with 23 other cyclists who form "Team Sarcoma," will embark on a Danish bike tour from today to Friday to raise money for sarcoma research. Sarcoma is a cancer of the connective tissues, such as nerves, muscles, joints, bone or blood vessels. It afflicts 1 percent of adults but is more common in children. The Shriviers came up with the idea of a "Virtual Bike Tour" for people who want to support their goals but can't be with them in Denmark. Virtual Bike Tour cyclists commit to bike on the very same days Team Sarcoma does, reporting to the Team Sarcoma Web site how far and where they biked.
